

**J. Parker and Kathryn Webb Dinius Fellowships**  
**Graduate School**  
**The Ohio State University**

**2007-2008**

The J. Parker and Kathryn Webb Dinius Fellowship Fund was established in April 1983 to provide support to students who plan to pursue or who are pursuing a graduate or professional degree at The Ohio State University on a full-time basis. Preference is given to students who earned an undergraduate varsity letter (with priority given to football players) at Ohio State. Consideration will also be given to prospective graduate students identified through the Graduate School's existing fellowship competitions. The Dinius Fellowship provides funds to defray and/or cover the cost of tuition, fees, other educational costs and/or living expenses.

**Eligibility**

Students pursuing study in post-baccalaureate degree programs in the Graduate School or the Colleges of Dentistry, Law, Medicine, Optometry, Pharmacy, and Veterinary Medicine are eligible for Dinius Fellowship consideration. For incoming graduate and professional students, prospective fellows must meet the minimum undergraduate grade point average and minimum score(s) on the appropriate admission test established by the prospective graduate/professional degree program. Continuing graduate and professional students must meet and maintain a minimum cumulative point hour ratio of 3.0, maintain appropriate academic progress, and remain in good standing in the Graduate School or appropriate professional program.

**Selection Process**

To be considered for the Dinius award applicants must complete a J. Parker and Kathryn Webb Dinius Fellowship application. The application must have the endorsement of the Graduate Studies Committee Chair of the student's prospective or current graduate degree program or Dean of the student's prospective or current professional degree program, or both, whichever is appropriate. If the applicant earned a varsity letter at Ohio State, the application must be endorsed by the University's Athletic Director. Applications for 2007-08 awards are due in the Graduate School no later than Tuesday, May 15, 2007.

Awards are made by the Graduate School. Recipients of the J. Parker and Kathryn Webb Dinius Fellowship will be announced in late-May.

**Renewals**

Dinius Fellows may also apply for renewal of their awards by completing an application form for that purpose. Renewal applications must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from the student's advisor and Graduate Studies Committee Chair (for students pursuing a graduate degree) or college Dean (for students pursuing a professional degree), or both, as appropriate. Fellowship renewals are contingent upon the fellow's making reasonable academic progress, remaining in good academic standing in the Graduate School and/or professional school and the availability of funds.
